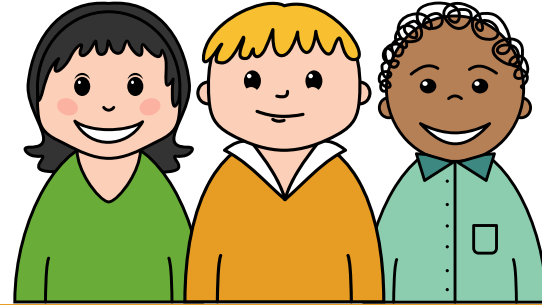




PANDEMIC-EBT FOR CHILDREN

What is P-EBT?

The Pandemic - Electronic Benefits Transfer (P-EBT) Program is **additional money for families to buy food due** to COVID-19 related school closures in March, April, and May of 2020. This means up to \$458 for each eligible child!



Who will get P-EBT?

This program is available to all Alaskan families with **school age children who received free and reduced-price school meals** in Alaska, or **attended a school where meals are free** during March, April, and May of 2020.

P-EBT benefits are **available to households regardless of immigrant status**, and benefits will not count in a public charge test.

How do I get P-EBT?

If you already receive SNAP (food stamps) benefits will be automatically loaded onto your card.

If you don't receive SNAP but receive free or reduced-price school meals, a form to opt-in has been mailed to you. **Forms must be mailed back and received by August 31st.**

If believe you are eligible but haven't received the form, or are concerned about the state receiving your paperwork before the August 31st deadline, contact Food Bank of Alaska:
