Thank you for your interest in providing professional development services which supports **thread**'s mission to improve the quality of early education in Alaska. **thread** maintains a pool of qualified trainers to facilitate professional development opportunities on a variety of topics in early childhood.

Qualifications

As of July 1, 2018, trainers and training associated with **thread** must meet the requirements to be approved by the Alaska System for Early Education Development (SEED). To qualify as a contract trainer for **thread** requires:

- Annual participation in the SEED Registry with trainer's education recognized as a level 10 or higher on the Career Ladder
- Trainer has applied for and is recognized as a SEED approved trainer

Compensation

Trainers are compensated for the time spent directly facilitating the training at a rate of \$100.00 an hour. This rate considers time spent in preparation and/or development as additional time spent outside of direct facilitation is not included.

In the Southcentral region, a contract is drawn up for each session the trainer has committed to with the Director of Professional Development.

Application

The contractor application is intended for gathering basic contact information of the trainer and to share thread's policies for contract trainers.

Upon receipt of this application, the Director of Professional Development will determine eligibility through confirmation with SEED that the above listed qualifications have been met. Trainers who have met these qualifications may be contacted to engage in planning training sessions.

thread Policies for Contract Trainers:

- Confidentiality As a representative of thread, contract trainers are expected to conduct themselves in a professional manner and follow practices of confidentiality. While facilitating training, trainers may learn of confidential information about families, children, early educators, and/or early care and learning facilities. Unauthorized discussion or release of confidential information may result in disciplinary action, up to and including termination of contract work for thread.
- Mandated Reporter Professionals in the early childhood field are mandated by law to report confirmed and suspected instances of child abuse and neglect to the appropriate law enforcement and/or social services agency within 24 hours. Any suspicion of child abuse and neglect as reported, observed, suspected or received in any manner while facilitating training for thread must also be reported to the thread's Director of Professional Development, Cassie Hulse, at 907.265.3114.
