Purpose of the Role

Floating Teachers provide flexible, responsive support across classrooms to ensure continuity of care, safety, and smooth daily operations.

Key Responsibilities

- Provide direct care and supervision in accordance with Alaska childcare licensing ratios.
- Support classroom routines, transitions, and daily flow as directed by Lead and Co-Teachers.
- Assist with implementation of planned activities.
- Maintain a safe, healthy, and nurturing learning environment.
- Provide break coverage and support during staff absences.
- Assist with cleaning, closing checklists, and center-wide routines.
- Communicate observations and concerns to classroom leadership.

Role Scope and Boundaries

This role does not include responsibility for lesson planning, formal family communication, or staff supervision.

Licensing Alignment

- Qualified caregiver under MOA Alaska Childcare Licensing.
- Supports compliance with health, safety, and sanitation regulations.
